Minimum requirements and training for the private pilot license are as follows:

40 Hours Total Flight /Training Time

- 20 Hours of Dual Flight Instruction
 - 3 Hours of Dual Night Flight
 - 3 Hours of Instrument Training
- 10 Hours of Solo Flight
 - 5 Hours of Solo Cross Country Flight
- 10 Hours of Ground Instruction

It is important to note: this is the MINIMUM training required to apply for the private pilots license. More time is normally required to attain the necessary proficiency to take your FAA private pilot practical examination and pass it on the first try. The current national training average is 60 to 70 hours.

FAA Requirements to Become a Private Pilot

You must be at least 17 years of age, be able to read, speak and understand the English language, receive an instructor's endorsement to take the required tests, pass the FAA written test and pass the FAA practical test.
